Course Description: The standards for Virginia and United States History include the historical development of American ideas and institutions from the Age of Exploration to the present. While focusing on political and economic history, the course instruction provides students with a basic knowledge of American culture through a chronological survey of major issues, movements, people, and events in Virginia and United States history. Students will use historical and geographical analysis skills to explore in depth the events, people, and ideas that fostered our national identity and led to our country' s prominence in world affairs. The study of history must emphasize the intellectual skills required for responsible citizenship.

Textbook: The course textbook is The American Vision; Virginia Edition, The McGraw-Hill Companies, 2010. The textbook is used as a class set and stored in the classroom. Students may check out textbooks as needed. Students receive enough materials in class to prepare them for assignments and assessments.
